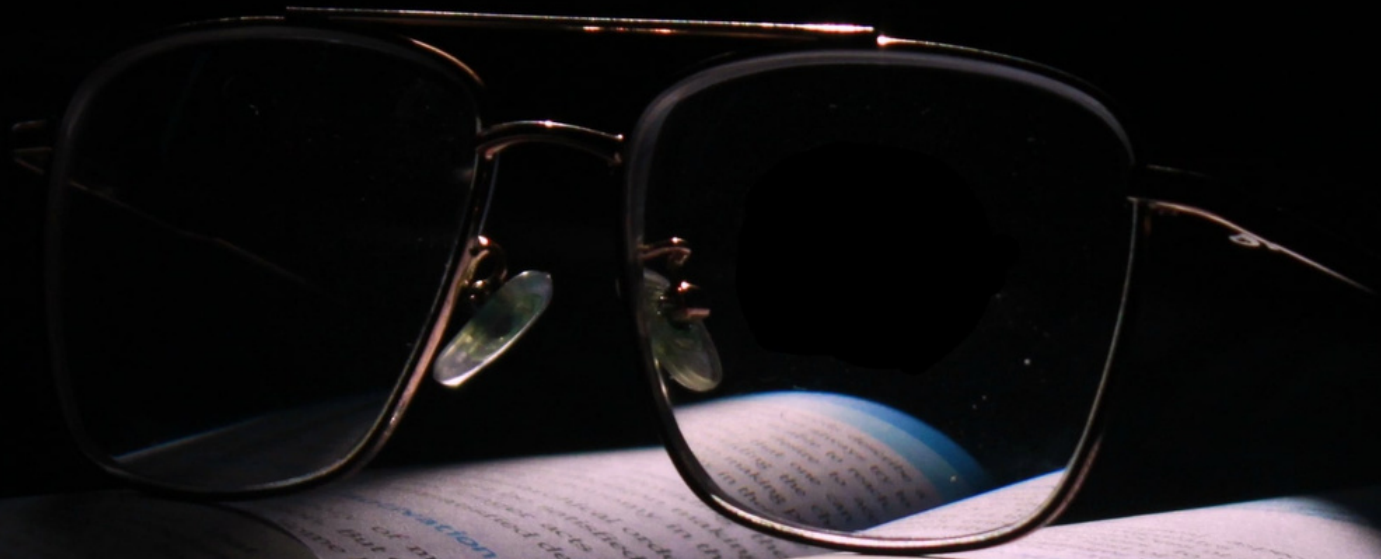

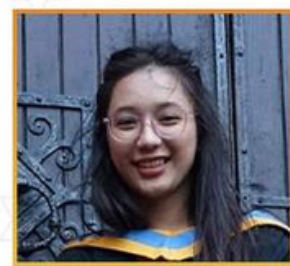

Empowering Session on 'Effective Habits' for Prime Wellness Students

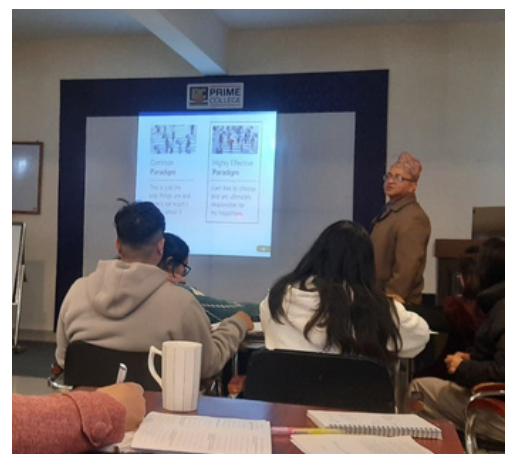

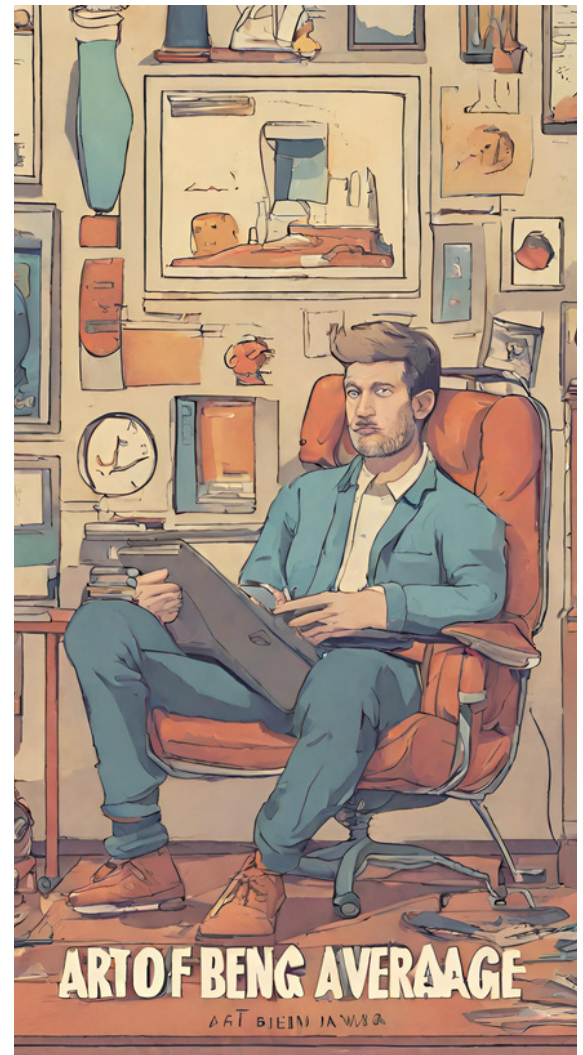
The Art of Being Average

If Time Flies, what does dreaming do?

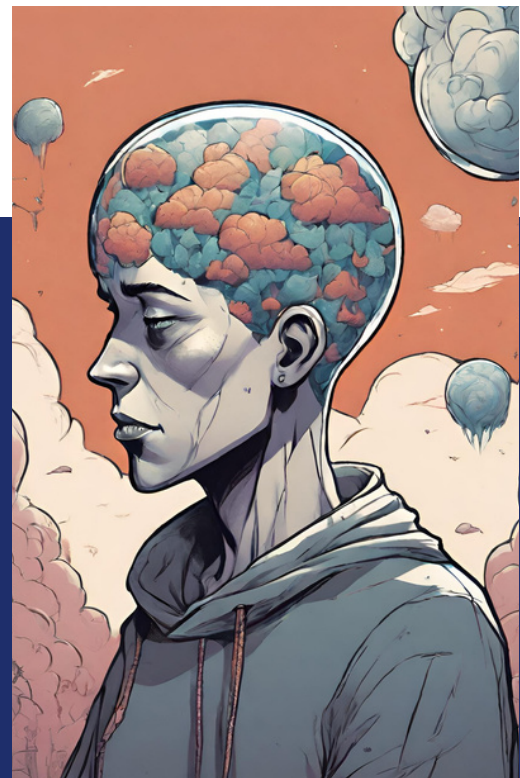

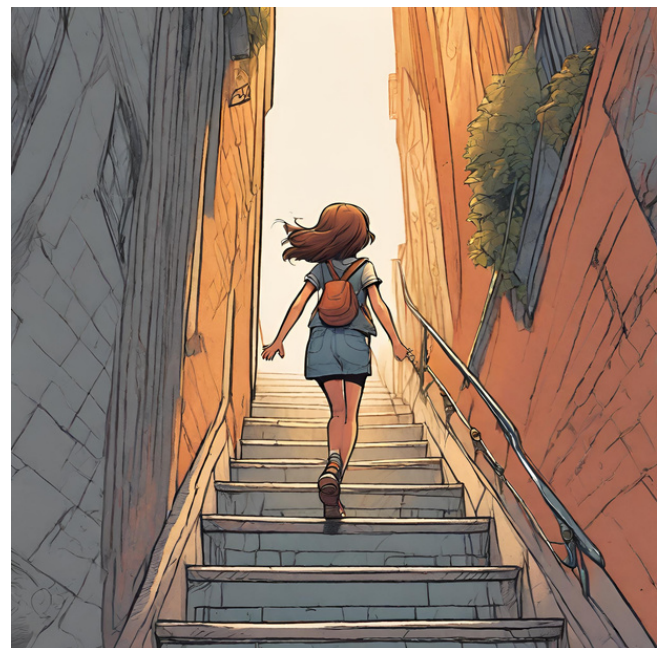

20TH CENTURY FEMINISM

In today's world where humans are exploring the heights of the universe and depths of the sea, women are still left fighting for what is- basic human rights. Be it in the grand form of dowry, sex selective abortion, or subtle perceptions that "women are weak", this is prevalent all over the globe irrespective of the nation. The opposition to this has led to a new movement, Feminism.

Feminism is a social, political, and cultural movement that seeks to establish and promote equal rights, opportunities, and status of all genders. Rooted in the belief that women should have the same rights as men, feminism challenges and aims to dismantle gender-based inequalities and stereotypes that persist in societies worldwide. The first wave started in the 19th century and had a notion of gender equality, rather than just a specific gender. This wave fought for legal equality for women- the right to vote, and to study. So, the "hard" part was done. The law did recognize women as "equal."



But the societal perception of women is still tough to change. The social structure and corporate culture still is very anti-women. Despite the 1st wave happening in the 19th century, the pay gap between men and women still exists. Women do not get the same amount of academic publications as men with similar competencies do, and women are less likely to receive promotions to leadership positions than men with corresponding expertise. Drugs for health problems are typically tested only in male samples or test results are not differentiated by gender, making it impossible to predict the effects of taking a particular drug separately for men and women. Women's health, especially reproductive health are still not studied properly or taken seriously either.

The commercialized version of feminism glosses over such critical issues. Since this new trend of feminism focuses so much on empowering man vs woman, these serious issues are not considered or simply ignored. Celebrities empower women to be themselves and call it feminism. Empowering young women is good, but you can't call it feminism if you don't address women's issues that have such a huge impact. The change happens not only by empowering but also by addressing the disparities in the traditional society against women.
