





### What Changed?

- AICPA introduced a new CPA Exam format in January 2024, known as CPA Evolution.
- The program curriculum and testing model has undergone significant changes to better align with the skills needed in the evolving accounting field.

### Why this change?

The goal of CPA Evolution is to modernize the CPA licensure process, recognizing the new skills and competencies required in today's and tomorrow's accounting practices.

### How does it impact me?

- The exam structure and exam windows for the Uniform CPA Exam has changed.
- It's crucial to plan your exam schedule strategically to increase your chances of success in this new format.



### **CPA Evolution: Major Transition**

Under the new CPA Exam structure introduced by CPA Evolution, the exam will continue to consist of four sections, each lasting four hours.

The Core will include three familiar sections: Financial Accounting and Reporting (FAR), Auditing and Attestation (AUD), and Regulation (REG); and an elective discipline section.
