



Bhintuna is a unique and culturally significant celebration for the Newar community of Nepal. Marking the start of the Newar lunar calendar, this festival is deeply rooted in the traditions, identity, and history of the Newar people. It is a tribute to Shankhadhar Sakhwa, who introduced Nepal Sambat as a symbol of independence and unity after liberating the people from debt. The streets come alive with parades featuring traditional Newari music, historical reenactments, masked dances, and participants dressed in traditional attire like Daura Suruwal and Haku Patasi. People visit temples to offer prayers, light oil lamps, and seek blessings for prosperity in the coming year.





Traditional Newari instruments, including two pairs of dhime drums and bhusyas, added energy and rhythm to the procession. The rally was a moment of unity, with participants dancing, hooting, and chanting slogans like "Nepal Sambat Rashtra Sambat" and "Bhintuna Yah Bhintuna Nhu Daya Bhintuna" to mark the New Year. It was a proud and festive celebration, bringing together Newari people from different castes and showcasing the cultural richness of the Newar community while fostering togetherness among students.

We celebrated Bhintuna 1145 with immense excitement and pride under the organization of the Prime Cultural Club. The rally, starting from Basantapur, was a vibrant and joyous event, representing the college's enthusiasm for cultural traditions. Students from both senior faculties and the +2 program joined forces to participate.



## 5. WHAT IS YOUR FAVOURITE MEMORY AT PRIME COLLEGE?


