**Start with skills, end with impact**

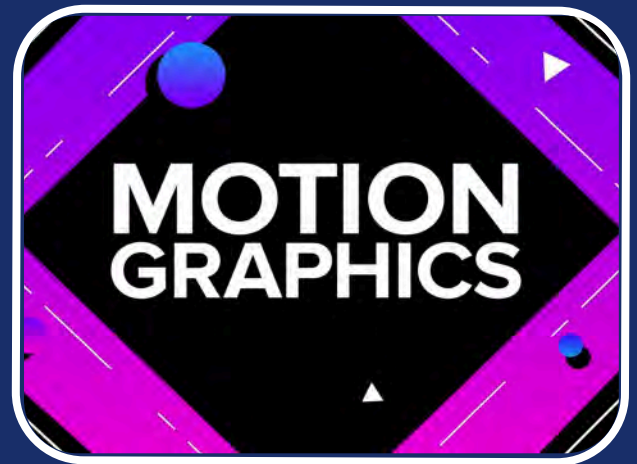
